

Population by Race, Including All Specific Combinations of Two Races, for the United States: 2010

This table provides a summary of the data included in the 2010 Redistricting Data Summary File. Data are shown for people who reported one race and for people who reported two or more races. In addition, the table shows the population in each of the 15 specific combinations of two races. People who reported two races constitute the vast majority of the Two or More Races population.

In addition to the 15 combinations of two races (e.g., White and Asian), there are 20 combinations of three races (e.g., White and Asian and Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander), 15 combinations of four races, 6 combinations of five races, and 1 combination of 6 races. The redistricting file includes data for the population in each of these 57 combinations of two or more races.
